President's Report:

Mike Ewanow moved that the report be approved as presented. This motion was seconded by Stephan Sawczuk. Motion carried unanimously.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Retreat: Mike Anuszkiewicz reported that we had a total of 40 people attended the recent Retreat. Half of these people were from St. Josaphats. Also, of the 40 attendees, 31 stayed for the whole weekend. There were 2 first time attendees. A wine raffle at the Retreat covered the expenses of a wine/cheese social on Saturday after Services. The \$200 deposit to the Retreat House for the 2011 Retreat has been rolled over to be the deposit for the 2012 Retreat. Dates for Retreat will be the last weekend of August. One

person received \$140 from the Retreat Assistance Fund. Stipend of \$500 for Fr. George was paid for by Parish. Bottom line for the 2011 Retreat was an overall profit of \$60. For next year's Retreat Leader Mike will contact our Bishop and if he is not available Mike has two or three other Priests who have indicated an interest in leading our Retreat. Mike thanked Father George for a great job and said that he received favorable responses from questioners filled out by Attendees. Mike will have pictures taken during retreat put up on the St. Josaphat's website. Gene Sydor asked Members to acknowledge Mike's hard work leading the Retreat effort with a round of applause.

He related that working alone he spent over 3 hours in the cold/rain doing this project. Gene said that if no help shows up for next years trimming he will no longer head up this project. President Pucher said that he will attempt to secure more help for this project next year.
